

ADVANCED PRACTITIONER OF HOMEOPATHY (APH)

DO YOU QUALIFY?

An applicant for a certificate to practice as an advanced practitioner of homeopathy must practice under the supervision of a homeopathic physician and possess:

1. A baccalaureate degree from a college or university, which is approved by the board or equivalent qualifications as, determined and approved by the board.
2. Successful completion of training in one of the following:
 - a. A program to become certified or licensed to practice as:
 - i. A nurse practitioner;
 - ii. A chiropractor; or
 - iii. An acupuncturist or doctor of oriental medicine;
 - b. A program to receive a degree from:
 - i. A domestic or foreign medical school approved by the board;
 - ii. A homeopathic medical school approved by the board; or
 - iii. A school of naturopathy approved by the board; or
 - c. Any other medical training approved by the board.
3. Successful completion of not less than 6 months (300 hours) of training in homeopathy.
4. Successful completion of the open book examination administered by the board.
