

HOMEOPATHIC ASSISTANT (HA)

DO YOU QUALIFY?

If you plan to work under the supervision of a homeopathic physician, you may need to be certified. To qualify, you must:

1. Be a high school graduate.
2. Successfully complete a training program approved by the board, which includes:
 - a. A medical assistant;
 - b. A physician's assistant;
 - c. A registered nurse;
 - d. A licensed practical nurse;
 - e. An emergency medical technician;
 - f. A medic in the Armed Forces; or
 - g. A medical technician.

You must complete 40 hours of training in homeopathic medicine from a program approved by the board, complete 160 hours of training under the supervision of a licensed homeopathic physician, and pass a written open book the examination administered by the board.
